Immerse within Nature.

"Our Family Forest" draws its inspiration from the lush woodland surroundings which gives the site its unique quality and setting for a contemplative and restorative club retreat set within nature.

Conceived as a series of pavilions and courtyards, the green courtyards form the distinguishing character surrounded by social and recreational components to encourage members to socialise, relax and forge communal and family bonds.



The new entrance provides an iconic entrance expression to invite members and visitors within. The building facade is built with timber in-grained concrete panels, providing an earthy tone and evoking a feeling of entering into a forest.





The new club amplifies the experience of being immersed in nature, with its architecture and material palette using natural materials such as timber - blending it seamlessly within the surrounding woodland. The programmes are clustered around the nature-infused courtyards to encourage members to socialise, congregate and forge stronger communal bonds.





The family water centre will form the new heart of the clubhouse with programmes such as a kids play area, dining areas and the club bar to be visually connected so that members can observe and immerse within an active and vibrant club environment.
