

BUKIT FREEHOLD LAND

DESIGN DEVELOPMENT UPDATE

In April 2019, members voted in favour to redevelop the Bukit Freehold Land (BFL) and for the design option by DP Architects for their “My Family Forest” proposal. Since then, the PRC2 has been working closely with the architects and consultants to streamline the facilities and spaces. A design development update will be presented by the PRC2 on Friday, 17 January 2020 before demolition works commence in February 2020.

The challenge in building a new Clubhouse on the BFL requires an exquisite skillset to preserve its tradition, and to ensure its facilities are futureproof from the ever-changing needs of a large community of members and their families.

KEY DESIGN DEVELOPMENTS

MINGLE @ BUKIT

A social space to facilitate members with digital workspaces to conduct formal and informal meetings, hold seminars, have group discussions and relax afterwards over coffee or tea prepared by in-house baristas. The previous ‘Co-working Space’ in the design proposal is now renamed to ‘Mingle @ Bukit’, which promises to provide an interactive space to network, meet, read, relax or just to meet old friends and colleagues. Junior members may also enjoy a conducive studying and reading environment.

GYMNASIUM

Our gymnasium is designed to provide members with state-of-the art equipment to meet the fitness needs of members, of various ages and gender.

BAR

SPORTS BAR

The sports bar caters to sporting interests of members who want to enjoy cold beers from the wide variety of taps, and enjoying golf or other sports on television. The casual setting serves as a space for members to forge stronger social bonds with one another over drinks and entertainment.

THE "GENTLEMEN'S" BAR

Located on the upper floor level, the bar would feature a wide selection of whiskies, wines and cocktails catered to purveyors of genteel drinking experiences and those looking to have private discussions over drinks. Inclusive of that there is no restriction to gender, the bar accommodates for all discerning members.
