MOBILE PHONE POLICY



DRESS REGULATIONS

The standards of dress which apply in the various areas of the Club's facilities and grounds are as follows:

IN THE CLUBHOUSE

Members' Locker Room Bar

Minimum standard is sporting attire, i.e. clothing which is permitted to be worn on the Course for golf or on the tennis courts for tennis.

Appropriate shoes are essential and may be worn without socks.

All shirts must be collared and tucked in (no T-shirts).

Wearing of hats, caps or visors is not permitted.

Niblick Bar

Minimum standard is sporting attire, i.e. clothing which is permitted on the Course for golf or on the tennis courts for tennis.

Appropriate shoes are essential and may be worn without socks.

All shirts must be collared (no T-shirts) and tucked in.

Wearing of hats, caps or visors is not permitted.

Carvery Bar & Upper Dining Room

Minimum standard is sporting attire, i.e. clothing which is permitted on the Course for golf or on the tennis courts for tennis.

Appropriate shoes are essential and may be worn without socks.

All shirts must be collared (no T-shirts) and tucked in.

Wearing of hats, caps or visors is not permitted.

Lower Dining Room

For Men, jackets (which must be worn at all times), tailored trousers and collared shirts are compulsory, ties are optional. Sports style shoes are not permitted.

For Women, smart casual is the minimum standard. Sports style shoes are not permitted.

Functions

For Men, 'Jacket and Tie' unless stated otherwise in the Fixture Book or specified in the invitations for special functions, such as theme nights, weddings etc.

For Women, the minimum standard is 'Smart Casual', unless stated otherwise in the Fixture Book or specified in the invitations for special functions, such as theme nights, weddings etc.

Swimming Pool Area

Members and guests must comply with the minimum dress standards that are applicable for areas of the Course or tennis courts after leaving the swimming pool area.

Northern Driving Range Building

The minimum standard is that which is permitted to be worn on the Course for golf.

Golf Shop

Hats, caps or visors may be worn in the Golf Shop.



DRESS REGULATIONS CONTINUED...

ON THE COURSE

Clothing bearing substantial advertising motifs or slogans is not permitted.
Only golf shoes with soft spikes specially manufactured for golf are permitted.
Sand/Sport shoes and other forms of casual shoes are not permitted, unless special dispensation is granted by the Chief Executive Officer for medical reasons.

FOR MEN

Permitted

Tailored trousers, Plus Fours and Plus Two's.
Conventional collared shirts, specifically designed for golf, tucked in at all times.
Tailored shorts, to the knee, with a belt and with socks.
White socks, either long or short.
Short socks must cover the ankle.
Long socks must be pulled up.

Not Permitted

Socks with large colour markings.
Shorts without socks.

FOR WOMEN

Permitted

Skirts, tailored slacks or shorts.
Tops and shirts designed to be worn outside must be hip length.

Not Permitted

Shorts and skirts that are shorter than mid-thigh in length.
Jeans and drawstring waisted pants or shorts.
Stretch pants, tracksuits, singlets, sun-tops, sneakers, joggers, sandals and flip-flops.

Denim jeans, torn pants, cargo pants, draw string pants, track suit pants and/or top, and below the knee pants are not acceptable anywhere in the Clubhouse, on the Course, or on any practice facility.

This does not apply to children under 12, but they must be neatly dressed at all times.



MOBILE PHONE POLICY

All 'Mobile Devices' must be on silent at all times in the Clubhouse and surrounds, on the Course, practice areas, the Golf Shop and Northern Driving Range Building (with the exception of the Communications Room at the Northern Driving Range Facility).

Phone Calls

Phone calls using mobile devices may not take place except in the following areas or circumstances:

- in the car park.
- in the Members' Locker Room entrance foyer (Members' Entrance).
- in the Associates' Powder Room.
- if special dispensation has been given by the Chief Executive Officer for medical reasons.
- in the Communications Room of the Northern Driving Range Facility.
- to call the Golf Shop.
- in the event of an emergency.

Diarising, Texting and Emailing

Diarising, texting on mobile phones and emailing is permitted throughout the Clubhouse, Northern Driving Range Facility and practice areas but not whilst on the Course.

Laptops and iPads

The use of Laptops and iPads is permitted in the Niblick Bar, Locker Rooms and in the Northern Driving Range Communications Room. They are not permitted elsewhere in the Club.

Personal Music Players

Listening to music on "mobile devices" with any form of ear phones or ear pods is NOT permitted in the Clubhouse or on the Course; with the exception of the Locker Rooms.

Earphones/earbuds etc may be used on all practice facilities, i.e. Northern and Southern Driving Ranges, chipping and putting greens.

GPS

'Mobile Devices' that have distance measuring capability may be used on the Course, but only whilst on silent mode.
