Course Marshal

Job Roles & Responsibilities:-

As a Marshal

- Address issues on the golf course such as dangerous play incidences, slow play and other on-course emergencies.
- Attend to calls and/or reports of dangerous play on the golf course and mediate where possible
- Monitoring pace of play – Patrol the golf course to ensure that play is smooth and regulated with no serious hold-ups by slow play
- Ensure golfers abide by the golf course etiquette and bye-laws on the golf course
- Report golfers who do not adhere to golf course etiquette and bye-laws on the golf course eg. maintain acceptable pace of play, repair divots and ball marks, rake bunkers etc
- Report errant golfers who choose to ignore orders after repeated reminders to the duty executive / manager in a timely manner
- Ensure all golfers adhere to course closure advisories and implement evacuation plans for the safety of all golfers
- Provide assistance during cases of emergency on the golf course
- Check and ensure that all golfers are accounted for and that there are no golfers on the golf course when the course is closed for the day
- Report abnormalities observed on the golf course to duty executive / manager in a timely manner
- Upkeep and maintain the Club's ambulance buggy and Marshal's buggy in a clean and serviceable condition
- Any other ad-hoc duties as assigned
